Therapy Services	In addition to providing direct therapy using online platforms, providing students with blizzard bag activities, weekly communication with families, and consulting with staff, related service providers continue to think outside the box and utilize materials that students have in their own homes.
	 Speech therapists have had success using scavenger hunts to work on speech sounds using familiar items they see at home. Collaborating with a Metzenbaum, Music Therapists have utilized AAC devices in order to participate in an online music class and model expectations for families. Therapists have reported that families are much more involved in sessions than before. Parents have mentioned that they have learned new tricks and tips through watching Zoom therapy, and they have seen their children do things that they have never seen before!
