

Program Description

BRC is an educational program that provides both therapeutic day treatment as well as academic instruction. Students (1st –12th grade) participate in therapeutic activity for 2 hours and 31 minutes throughout the day integrated with grade level academic instruction. Classroom staffing is comprised of a Therapist, Intervention Specialist, and Paraprofessional. Kindergarten students participate in 90 minutes of skill building throughout the day led by a Therapeutic Behavior Support (TBS) specialist. The remainder of the day is included in the general kindergarten classroom with Intervention Specialist and Paraprofessional support. Each classroom can accommodate a maximum of six students. Wrap around services for home/school continuity are available through the TBS for all classes.
